### **APPLICATION**

INTERCOAST OIL AND GAS COMPANY, through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for an order approving its McMillan Exploratory Unit Agreement and in support of this application states:

1. That the proposed Unit Agreement consists of 160 acres, more or less, of fee lands, situated in Lea County, New Mexico. The horizontal limits of said unit are described as follows:

## Township 14 South, Range 38 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 34:

W/2 NE/4, E/2 NW/4

- 2. The Unit Agreement has been approved by a sufficient percentage of the interest owners within the proposed Unit Area to provide effective control of unit operations.
- 3. The Applicant, InterCoast Oil and Gas Company, is designated as Unit Operator in said Unit Agreement and all oil and gas in the Devonian formation unitized.
  - 4. The proposed Unit Area covers all, or substantially all, of the geological

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structures or anomaly involved.

5. InterCoast proposed to drill its McMillan 34-2 Well as the initial test well on

the unit at an unorthodox well location in the Devonian formation 1275 feet from the North

line and 2600 feet from the East line (Unit B) of said Section 34.

Said Unit Agreement and the unitized operation and management of the Unit

Area will be in the interest of conservation and the prevention of waste, and that it will

protect the correlative rights of all parties concerned.
