MR. CARR: Mr. Catanach, these cases were originally presented to a Division Examiner in September of the year 2000. At the time of the hearing the Examiner

requested additional data be provided. The data has been provided.

All parties have now been renotified, with the exception of Alpha Resources, Inc., and we've previously provided to the Division a copy of the assignment of the interests which are at issue from Alpha Resources, Inc., to Saga Petroleum.
