STOGNER: We will go to page four now and call Case Number 8850, which is in the matter of the hearing called by the Oil Conservation Division on its own motion for an order creating and extending certain pools in Eddy and Chaves Counties, New Mexico.

We will now call for appearances.

MR. TAYLOR: May it please the Examiner, my name is Jeff Taylor, Counsel for the Oil Conservation Division, and I have one witness to be sworn.

MR. STOGNER: Are there any other appearances?

Will the witness please stand?

(Witness sworn.)

MR. STOGNER: Please continue, Mr. Taylor.

ERNIE BUSCH,
being called as a witness and being duly sworn upon his oath, testified as follows, to-wit:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. TAYLOR:

Q Will you please state your name, place of residence, and employment for the record?

A Ernest L. Busch with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division, Aztec District.

Q Mr. Busch, have you previously testified before the Commission or its examiners before and had your credentials accepted?

A Yes, I have.

MR. TAYLOR: Mr. Examiner, I tender the witness as an expert.

MR. STOGNER: Mr. Busch is so qualified.

Q Mr. Busch, are you prepared to make recommendations to the Examiner today concerning the nomenclature of certain pools in Eddy and Chaves Counties, New Mexico?

A Yes.

Q Are your recommendations prepared in the form of an exhibit?

A They are.

Q And how is that exhibit denominated?

A In paragraphs?

Q No, as 1 or A, or is it numbered?

1	A	One.
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2 Q Okay, Exhibit One?

3 A Exhibit One.

4 Q Would you then refer to Exhibit One and
5 to the docket that's been prepared and handed out at the
6 hearing this morning and point out any substantial differ-
7 ences between the two?

8 A Yes, there are some differences.

9 Paragraph (f) should be dismissed. the
10 creation of Sieqrest Draw-Wolfcamp Pool.

11 An addition to paragraph (j), High Lone-
12 some-Queen Pool, add Section 18, the east half of the south-
13 east quarter.

14 Q Are there any other corrections or chan-
15 ges?

16 A No, that's it.

17 Q Do you have anything further to add to
18 your testimony here?

19 A No, I don't.

20 Q Was, what was it, Exhibit One prepared by
21 you or under --

22 A This is Exhibit One.

23 Q -- your supervision and control?

24	A	Yes.
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25 MR. TAYLOR: Mr. Examiner, I'd

1 like to move the admission of Exhibit One and that's all we
2 have in this case.

3 MR. STOGNER: Exhibit One will
4 be admitted into evidence at this time.

5 Is there anything further in
6 Case Number 8850?

7 If not, this case will be taken
8 under advisement.
