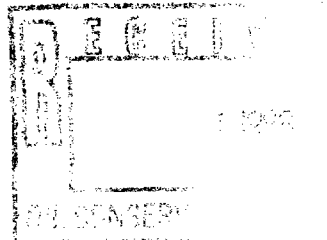

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:


Case No. 9513 is hereby dismissed.
