

STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT

Matador Petroleum Corporation seeks approval of an unorthodox gas well location to test the Morrow formation within a mile of the current boundary of the Buffalo Valley-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico.

Matador Petroleum Corporation proposes to drill its well at an unorthodox surface location 660 feet FEL and 660 feet FNL (Unit A) of Section 30, T15S, R28E, NMPM and to dedicate the N/2 of said Section 30 to the well.

The well is an attempt to locate lower Morrow production in a north-south oriented sand channel where the point of greatest net thickness is on the east side of the spacing unit

The unorthodox location would provide an opportunity to encounter the point of greatest thickness of that sand package with this spacing unit.
