STOVALL: Application of Hanson Operating 4 5 Company, Inc., for a high-angle/horizontal directional drilling pilot project and for special operating rules 6 7 therefor, Roosevelt County, New Mexico. 8 EXAMINER STOGNER: Call for appearances. 9 MR. CARR: May it please the Examiner, my name is 10 William F. Carr with the Santa Fe law firm Campbell, Carr, Berge and Sheridan. 11 12 I represent Hanson Operating Company, and I have 13 a statement to present to the Examiner. 14 EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay, Mr. Carr. 15 MR. CARR: May it please the Examiner, as you are aware, in October of 1993 Hanson Operating Company drilled 16 its Tuxedo Federal Number 1 well 1990 from the south line 17 and 2004 feet from the east line in Section 17, Township 8 18 South, Range 37 East, in Roosevelt County, New Mexico. 19 The well was originally drilled as a straight 20 Hanson was unable to make a successful well in the 21 hole. San Andres formation. 22 At that time they contacted both the Hobbs and 23 Santa Fe offices of the Oil Conservation Division and were 24 25 given a verbal authorization to continue drilling and to

attempt to drill a horizontal well in this formation.

The authorization, however, was limited. Hanson was to drill at its own risk, and they were advised that no allowable would be assigned for the well until there was a hearing notice and an order approving the horizontal well.

As you also know, they were unable to make a horizontal well, although they worked on the well for over 60 days.

I have presented to you, Mr. Examiner, two documents. One is a copy of a sundry notice, approved by the BLM on December 13th, which approved a plugging program for the horizontal portion of the wellbore and also authorized Hanson to leave the well in a temporarily abandoned status for a twelve-month period of time, during which they can determine whether or not they want to attempt a Bough C completion with this well.

The second document is a gyro survey which describes the horizontal portion of the wellbore.

Since we have been unsuccessful in our attempts to make a well to date, we would request that Exhibits 1 and 2 be taken into the file on this matter and that Case 10,058 [sic] then be dismissed.
