

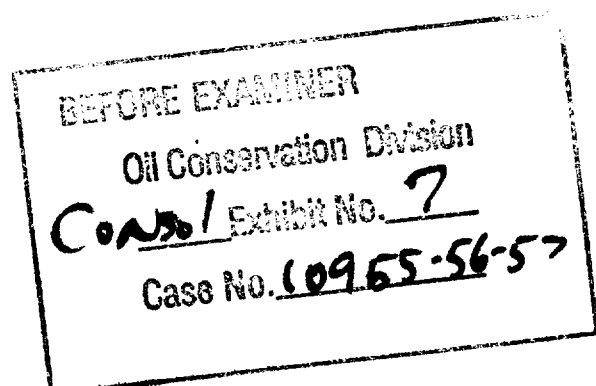

Dear Mr. Lemay:

Please accept this letter as our formal request for an extension to commence drilling operations as provided for in Order No. R-9033 issued by the Oil Conservation Commission effective November 3, 1989, and as extended (to May 1, 1990) by your letter dated December 11, 1989.

Richmond Petroleum has completed all the necessary steps to commence the drilling of the well. However, we have unfortunately been delayed by the immediate unavailability of the type of reserve pit liner that has been required by the Bureau of Reclamation. We have been informed that it will take another 12-13 days for the liner to be delivered. We will have the location work begun by the May 1 deadline, but the drilling operations must wait until the pit liner is installed. Thus, Richmond Petroleum Inc. would hereby respectfully request that the commission grant us an extension of time until May 27, 1990 in order to commence drilling operations on the subject well. The May 27 date is the date that the APD expires on the subject well.
