

CASE ¹⁰⁹⁶²____: Application of Maralo, Inc. for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Delaware formation underlying the NE/4SE/4 of Section 30, T23S, R30E, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and/or pools developed on 40-acre oil spacing within said vertical extent, which presently includes but is not necessarily limited to the Nash Draw-Brushy Canyon Pool, the Nash Draw-Cherry Canyon Pool or the Forty Niner Ridge-Delaware Pool. Said unit is to be dedicated to a well to be drilled and completed at a standard oil well location in Unit I of said Section 30. Also to be considered will be the costs of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the costs thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as the operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said unit is located approximately 6.5 miles southwest from Harroun, New Mexico.






