
Application of Yates Energy Corporation for pool creation, classification of the new pool as an associated pool, and for special pool rules, Eddy County,

#### Gentlemen:

Oil Conservation Division Order No. R-9922 entered on July 6, 1993 in Case No. 10748 established Temporary Special Pool Rules and Regulations for the Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Associated Pool. Pursuant to this order, this case was to be reopened in January, 1995, to permit operators in the pool to appear and show cause why these Special Pool Rules should not be rescinded.

Most of the eighteen month life of these temporary rules was consumed by an environmental audit. Currently development operations are underway but only limited data is available and should permanent rules be adopted at this time, they may well have to be amended when the results of current development efforts are known. Therefore, a one year extension of these temporary rules is needed.

The other operators in the pool are: Nearburg Exploration Company, Santa Fe Energy, and Marathon Oil Company. Each of these operators has been contacted about a one year continuance of the special pool rules and regulations for the Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Associated Pool and none of them object to a continuance.

Yates Petroleum Corporation, therefore requests that the Temporary Pool Rules established by Order No. R-9922 be continued in full force and effect until January, 1996 and that Case No. 10748 be reopened at that time to permit operators in this pool to appear and show cause why the temporary rules should not be rescinded.

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
