



Shelton, III nor Dune Petroleum Corporation has applied for or received the necessary rights of-way or surface use permits required by federal law.

As the beneficial owner of the surface rights which would be affected by drilling the proposed wells described above, the Jicarilla Apache Tribe hereby requests that the Oil Conservation Division give notice to the Tribe prior to approving any application for permission to drill these wells. 


