This matter came on for hearing before the Oil Conservation Commission, LORI WROTENBERY, Chairman, on Thursday, August 26th, 1999, at the New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department, Porter Hall, 2040 South Pacheco, Santa Fe, New Mexico, Steven T. Brenner, Certified Court Reporter No. 7 for the State of New Mexico.

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1 WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 8:30 a.m.: 2 3 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Good morning, it's August 4 5 26th, 1999, at about 8:30 a.m. This is a meeting of the Oil Conservation 6 Commission in Santa Fe, New Mexico, in the Oil Conservation 7 Division conference room. We have two items on our agenda 8 9 today. 10 We're going to start the meeting with Case This was the Application of Pendragon Energy 11 12 Partners, Inc., and J.K. Edwards Associates, Inc., to confirm production from the appropriate common source of 13 14 supply in San Juan County, New Mexico. 15 We have heard the testimony in this case over the last couple of weeks, and now the Commission will be going 16 17 into executive session to deliberate on this particular case for about 30 minutes here. 18 And then we'll come back into open session about 19 nine o'clock to take up Case 12,033, the Application of 20 21 Public Service Company of New Mexico for review of the Oil Conservation Division directive dated March 13th, 1998, 22 23 directing Applicant to perform additional remediation for hydrocarbon contamination in San Juan County, New Mexico. 24

But we'll go off the record right now for

purposes of deliberation. 1 MS. HEBERT: We need a motion. 2 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: I'm sorry, we need a motion 3 first to go into executive session. 4 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: I so move. 5 6 COMMISSIONER LEE: Second. 7 MS. HEBERT: And you're going into executive session to deliberate the matters in the Pendragon case. 8 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I move that. 9 COMMISSIONER LEE: Second. 10 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: All in favor say "Aye". 11 12 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye. 13 COMMISSIONER LEE: Aye. CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Aye. 14 Anything else, Ms. Hebert? Thank you. 15 16 (Thereupon, a recess was taken at 8:32 a.m.) 17 (The following proceedings had at 9:03 a.m.) CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: We'll go back on the 18 record, now. 19 The Commission was in executive session for about 20 30 minutes deliberating on OCD Case Number 11,996. 21 22 was the Application of Pendragon Energy Partners, Inc., and Edwards Energy Corporation, Inc., to confirm production 23 from the appropriate common source of supply in San Juan 24 25 County, New Mexico.

1	The only thing that the Commission discussed when
2	we were in executive session was this particular matter,
3	and we have completed our deliberations for today. They
4	will continue at a future date after we receive the
5	proposed orders from the parties and the transcript of the
6	case.
