Applicant pledges this sum as a guarantee that it, its executors, assigns, heirs or administrators shall plug the wells owned or operated by him if dry, or when abandoned, in accordance with the rules and orders of the Oil Conservation Division of the State of New Mexico in such a way as to confine the oil, gas, and water in the strata in which they are found, and to prevent same from escaping to other strata. If the applicant does not so properly plug and abandon said wells upon order of the Division, the total sum of the bond shall be forfeited to the Division, and such amount as is necessary may be used to properly plug said wells. If the principal sum of this bond is less than the actual cost incurred by the Division in plugging said wells, the applicant, its successors, assigns, heirs, or administrators shall be liable under the provisions of Section 70-2-38 NMSA 1978 of the Oil and Gas Act, and the Division may take action to recover any amounts expended over and above the principal sum of the bond.

NOW THEREFORE, if the above applicant or its successors, assigns, heirs, or administrators or any of them shall plug the wells owned or operated by it when dry or abandoned, in accordance with the rules, regulations, and orders of the Division, in such a manner as to confine the oil, gas, and water in the strata in which they naturally occur, and to prevent them from escaping into other strata, and further to clean up the surface location of said wells, NOW THEREFORE, this obligation shall be null and void and the principal sum shall be paid to the applicant, or its successors, heirs, or administrators.
