Dear Ms. Wrotenbery:

Commission Order No. R-11636-A, entered on November 6, 2001, requires Mewbourne to provide a schedule of estimated well costs to each non-consenting working interest owner within 30 days of entry of the order, and give them 30 days to elect to join in the well.

See Ordering Paragraph No. 8. As testified to at hearing, all non-consenting working interest owners were provided with such notice after the Division entered its order, but did not elect to join in the well within the 30 day election period. Also, the non-consenting working interest owners did not seek a stay of the Division's order pending appeal. As a result, they should not be entitled to an additional election period. Therefore, as requested at hearing, Mewbourne requests entry of an amended order, effective November 5, 2001, deleting Ordering Paragraph No. 8 and the third sentence of Finding Paragraph No. 18. Thank you for your consideration of this matter.
