WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 8:42 a.m.: EXAMINER STOGNER: Since this is fresh in my 3 mind, I'm going to call Case Number 12,919 at this time. 4 5 MR. BROOKS: Mr. Examiner, I'm David Brooks, 6 Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department of the State of New Mexico, as the general counsel, appearing for 7 the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division which is the 8 Applicant in this case. 9 EXAMINER STOGNER: Any other appearances? 10 May it please the Examiner, 11 MR. FELDEWERT: Michael Feldewert with the Santa Fe office of Holland and 12 Hart, and I'm appearing on behalf of Rice Operating 13 Company. 14 15 EXAMINER STOGNER: Thank you. Mr. Brooks? 16 MR. BROOKS: Mr. Examiner, it is my understanding 17 -- Well, I'll give you a capsule background on this. 18 This involves an abatement plan. Under Rule 19 19 20 an abatement plan can be approved administratively unless 21 there is an objection. If there are objections, then it's 22 discretionary with the Director whether to set those objections for hearing. 23 In this case there were objections from a surface 24 The case was set for hearing. However, pending the 25 owner.

hearing, which has pended for quite a while, the property was transferred and was acquired by an affiliate of OXY USA, and it's my understanding that the new surface owner is withdrawing those objections. The City of Hobbs, which also filed objections, is likewise withdrawing its objections. And it's my understanding also that Rice Operating Company, represented here by Mr. Feldewert, has agreed to accept the conditions imposed upon the plan by the Division.

And based on all those understandings, I am requesting -- the Division is requesting that this case be dismissed.

EXAMINER STOGNER: Mr. Feldewert?

MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, what Mr. Brooks laid out is indeed correct. Occidental has acquired the property from the surface owner.

I spoke with the attorney for the City of Hobbs yesterday. He has likewise stated that they have no objection to the remediation plan, and Rice is prepared to proceed with the remediation at this site pursuant to the additional conditions that were placed by the Division, I believe by letter dated May 30th, 2000.

EXAMINER STOGNER: Mr. Brooks, you've asked that this matter be dismissed. Now, will this be remanded back to the Environmental Bureau for administrative handling?

1 MR. BROOKS: Yes, the approval of the abatement 2 plan from this point on will be handled administratively by 3 the Environmental Bureau of the Division. EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay, so it's this particular 4 5 case and not the Application that's being essentially dismissed at this time? 6 7 MR. BROOKS: Well --EXAMINER STOGNER: It will be handled by the 8 administrative process of the --9 MR. BROOKS: Yeah --10 EXAMINER STOGNER: -- Environmental --11 MR. BROOKS: -- the case Application, the 12 Application that I filed, is being dismissed. 13 abatement plan is not being dismissed, it's going to 14 continue in effect and will be approved administratively. 15 EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay, thank you, Mr. Brooks. 16 17 If there's nothing further in Case 12,919, then this case will be dismissed at this time. 18 Thank you, Mr. Examiner. 19 MR. 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WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 8:35 a.m.:

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EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay, we'll go over the docket continuances and dismissals at this time.

First page, Case 13,137, this is the Application of Richardson Production Company to amend a compulsory pooling order. This matter was advertised in the absence of objection. Unfortunately, the advertisement in the paper in San Juan County missed the most important half of this ad, and it had to be readvertised for October 9th. So Case 13,137 will be continued and readvertised for October the 9th.

The next case, 13,138, Application of Apache Corporation for compulsory pooling, Lea County, this case will be continued to September the 18th.

The third case on this page, Case 13,126, Application of (The) Wiser Oil Company for three unorthodox locations, Lea County, this case will be continued to October the 9th.

Page 2, second case, 13,087, Ocean Energy, compulsory pooling, Lea County, this case will be dismissed.

Case 13,139, Application of Gruy Petroleum Management Company to expand the White City-Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico, this case will be

continued to September 18th.

Case 13,140 is another Application of Gruy

Petroleum Management Company. After a prehearing meeting
with the parties involved in this matter yesterday, this
case will be dismissed.

Case 13,133, this is the Application of Devon Energy Production Company, L.P., for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, this case will be continued to September the 18th.

Moving to the third page, Case 13,141, this is the Application of EOG Resources, Inc., for the reinstatement of a particular order that has to do with special pool rules of the Diamond-Strawn Pool, and this is in Lea County. This case will be continued to September the 4th.

Case 13,142, down at the bottom, this is the Application of the Oil Conservation Division.

MR. BROOKS: I'm sorry, Mr. Examiner, you said on 13,141 that it will be continued to September the 4th.

This is September the 4th.

EXAMINER STOGNER: That is September the 4th, pardon me. This case will be -- I'm sorry, let's go back. Case 13,141 -- that's the Application of EOG Resources -- this case will be dismissed. I apologize.

Okay, down at the bottom 13,142, this is the

Application of the Oil Conservation Division for an order requiring Maralo, LLC, to remediate a hydrocarbon contamination at an abandoned well and battery site in Lea County. This case will be continued to October the 9th.

Okay, I believe there's -- Are there any other continuances or dismissals?

MR. FELDEWERT: May it please the Examiner, on page 3, Case Number 13,103 which is the Application of V-F Petroleum, I believe that case has been continued. I don't recall the date, but it's my understanding that case has been continued.

EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay, let me see if the case file has anything. Okay, the last thing I have in the file is a continuance from August the 7th to the 4th, and I see that that's Mr. Bill Carr with Holland and Hart. I don't have any other continuing notice in front of me. Shall I just assume that this is continued to the 18th of September?

MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, I did enter an appearance in that case on behalf of BP America Production Company, and I know the parties are attempting to work out their differences with respect to compulsory pooling. So the last I heard, it was going to be continued. And I would request on behalf of my client that it be continued to the 18th.

1 EXAMINER STOGNER: I'm sorry, to the 18th of September? 2 3 MR. FELDEWERT: September 18th would be fine. 4 EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay. And that's the only 5 thing I have on it. So for Mr. Bruce and Mr. Feldewert, 6 Case 13,103 will be continued to September the 18th. MR. BROOKS: Mr. Examiner --7 8 EXAMINER STOGNER: Yes. MR. BROOKS: -- Case Number 12,919, the 9 Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for 10 a public hearing pursuant to Rule 19.G(3) to consider the 11 12 adequacy of a revised State 2 abatement plan, that case is to be dismissed.
