APPLICATION

Santa Fe Energy Operating Partners, L.P., hereby applies for approval of four non-standard spacing and proration units in the W½ Section 2 and W½ Section 11, Township 22 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof would show:

- 1. Applicant is the sole working interest owner in the W½ of Section 2 and the NW¼ and W½SW¼ of Section 11, Township 22 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, insofar as rights to the Wolfcamp formation are concerned.
- 2. The W_2^1 of Section 2 and W_2^1 of Section 11 are located within one mile of the East Carlsbad-Wolfcamp Gas Pool, and thus are subject to the special rules for said pool.
- 3. The East Carlsbad-Wolfcamp Gas Pool special pool rules provide for 320 acre spacing and proration units.
- 4. Geological and engineering evidence will show that one well will not efficiently and adequately drain 320 acres in the Wolfcamp formation, and thus Applicant requests approval of four 160 acre non-standard spacing and proration units, as further described below.
- 5. Applicant is the operator of the Chase State No. 2-1 well, located 1980 feet from the west line and 990 feet from the

south line of said Section 2. The Chase State No. 2-1 Well is located at an unorthodox location approved by Division administrative order NSL-2302, and is capable of producing from the Wolfcamp formation. Applicant seeks to dedicate this well to a non-standard spacing and proration unit for Wolfcamp production consisting of the SW½ of Section 2.

- 6. If this Application is approved, Applicant proposes to drill additional wells in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, to test the Wolfcamp formation.
- 7. In order to prevent waste and protect correlative rights, applicant requests approval of a 160 acre non-standard spacing and proration unit for Wolfcamp production consisting of the SW½ of Section 2 to be dedicated to the Chase State No. 2-1 Well, and advance approval for three 160 acre non-standard spacing and proration units for Wolfcamp production consisting of the NW½ of Section 2, the NW½ of Section 11, and the SW½ of Section 11 to be dedicated to wells to be drilled thereon.
- 8. Applicant further requests that the Chase State No. 2-1 Well, and the three proposed wells, be allowed to produce hydrocarbons from the Wolfcamp formation at their full productive capacity with no restriction on their allowables.
- 9. Applicant requests that this matter be set for the October 7, 1987 Examiner hearing.
