Dear Ms. Davidson:

Late yesterday the attorney representing M.D. Mark, Inc. contacted me. M.D. Mark provided seismic data to Nearburg which Nearburg was planning to introduce as Exhibit 7 at the October 21 and 22 Commission hearing in the above referenced case. M.D. Mark's attorney, however, informed me that the seismic data is a trade secret and threatened that any use of the data, even in a hearing before the Commission, would be an unacceptable disclosure and would represent a beach of the license agreement. M.D. Mark has demanded that I prevent use and disclosure of this seismic information.

Today, we again attempted to obtain permission from M.D. Mark to use the data at the hearing. We were not successful. Therefore, I request that all copies of Exhibit 7 previously filed with the Commission be returned as soon as possible.

With this letter, we are also advising the Commission and all counsel of record that Nearburg cannot seek to introduce this data during the hearing, and therefore, does not intend to call a geophysical witness at the October 21 and 22 hearing.

Enclosed are the revised exhibits of Nearburg Exploration Company, L.L.C. which I have previously identified in letters to Mr. Ross. As I advised in my letter of September 30, 2002, the enclosed cross sections (Revised Nearburg Exhibits 5 and 6) have only been revised to make them easier to read. The location map contains information contained on Nearburg's Orientation Plat and will be used as a demonstrative exhibit during the hearing to identify certain wells to the Commission as we work through our testimony. The purpose of these exhibits is to facilitate our presentation of evidence and contain only information contained in the exhibits produced on September 4, 2002. Pursuant to my letter of October 2, 2002, I enclose a revised structure map (Revised Nearburg Exhibit No. 8) which has been changed to correct control discrepancies in an area approximately two miles to the northeast of Section 34. The revisions do not affect the mapping in of the Morrow formation in Section 34.
