FINDS THAT:

(1) Tommy Robbins, a respondent in this case, filed a timely application for de novo review of Order No. R-12339 issued on April 26, 2005.

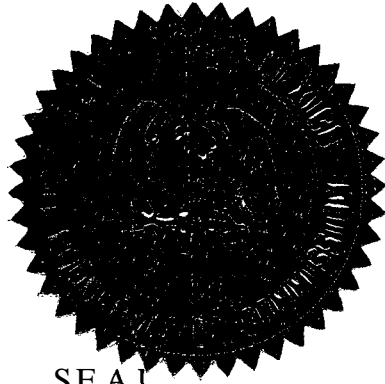
