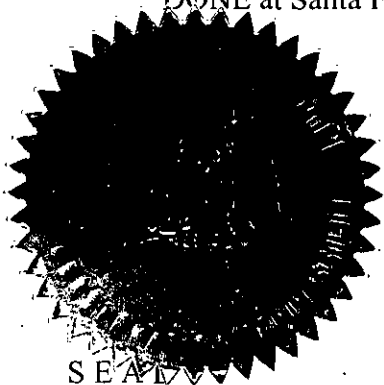

ORDER SETTING HEARING DATE

The Oil Conservation Commission Chair, after reviewing the notice requirements for rulemaking applications, finds as follows:

That the Application of the New Mexico Oil and Gas Association to repeal and replace Title 19, Chapter 15, Part 34 addressing produced water, drilling fluids and other liquid oil field waste, and to amend the definition of produced water in Title 19, Chapter 15, Part 2, of the New Mexico Administrative Code, is hereby set for hearing before a quorum of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, beginning on February 13, 2015, and continuing for so long thereafter and on such schedule as the Commission shall deem necessary.
