Dear Ms. Lawrence:

Our records indicate that Apache Corporation is the Operator of Record for the Pacifico State San Andres Unit area, Lea County, New Mexico.

Our records reflect the following:

- The Pacifico State San Andres Unit Agreement was approved effective December 15, 2015.
- Section 8 of the Unit Agreement titled "Drilling to Discovery" states:

"Until a discovery of a deposit of unitized substances capable of being produced in paying quantities (to wit: quantities sufficient to repay the costs of drilling and producing operations with a reasonable profit) unit operator shall continue drilling diligently, one well at a time, allowing not more than six months between the completion of one well and the beginning of the next well, until a well capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities is completed to the satisfaction of the Commissioner or until it is reasonably proven to the satisfaction of the unit operator that the unitized land is incapable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities in the formation drilled hereunder."

- The initial test well for Pacifico State San Andres Unit was completed on August 5, 2016 (New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's well report of First Oil Production).
- Based on the unit agreement, six months from completion of the initial test well was February 1, 2017.
- As of today's date (April 25, 2017), Apache has neither received a commercial determination for the initial test well nor spud a second test well in the Pacifico State San Andres Unit. The commitment for these events is overdue by more than 80 days.

The New Mexico State Land Office sent an advance notification of termination dated March 20, 2017, indicating that unless Apache Corporation provided adequate reasons for continuing the unit agreement, the unit would be terminated after 30 days had elapsed.

Pursuant to Section 8 of the Unit Agreement, the Commissioner of Public Lands has this date (April 25, 2017) terminated the Pacifico State San Andres Unit.
