Dear Land Manager:

We have received your letter of June 14, 2018, along with your economic analysis and additional information as revisions to the Quail Queen Unit 2018 Plan of Development/Operation. Based on your paying quantities analysis, the New Mexico State Land Office has this date approved the referenced Plan of Development/Operation. Our approval is conditional on approval from all relevant agencies.

We may contact you at a later date regarding the following:

- The possibility of drainage by wells outside the unit area, and
- A need for further development of the unit.

Please note the following about your 2019 Plan of Development/Operation:

- Due March 1, 2019.
- The submission should include
 - 1. A section that outlines ongoing development and/or maintenance in 2019 (address new drilling, recompletions, workovers, P&As, and any other activities that may impact production);
 - 2. An economic analysis showing that the unit is producing in paying quantities (that is, quantities sufficient to repay the costs of drilling and producing operations with a reasonable profit);
 - 3. An aerial photo (preferred) or map that illustrates both current and planned infrastructure for the unit: well locations, tank batteries, gathering systems, and any other facilities that may impact the surface of New Mexico State Trust lands;
 - 4. A list of active wells in the unit with their API numbers; and
 - 5. Any additional information that may have relevance to our approval of the Plan.
