BY THE DIVISION:

This case came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on August 8, 2019 at Santa Fe, New Mexico before Examiner Leonard R. Lowe.

NOW, on this 27th day of February 2020, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendation of the Examiner,

FINDS THAT:

The information submitted though affidavit is inaccurate in the following areas:

Exhibit A was missing and was requested on January 24, 2020 and received February 24, 2020

The C-102 does not match the Exhibit A or the APD regarding the well name and bottom hole location.

The C-102 does not match the Exhibit A regarding the Spacing Unit Size.

The AFE reflects a cost estimate for a measured depth of 18,943 feet where the APD has a proposed depth of 11,920 feet.

The APD is intended for a 2nd Bone Spring Sand where Exhibit A and in hearing it was stated that these wells are for 3rd Bone Spring Testing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

This case is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
