**ORDER ON INTREPID POTASH-NEW MEXICO LLC'S
EMERGENCY APPLICATION TO PREVENT PUBLICATION OF

This matter came before the Commission on Intrepid Potash-New Mexico LLC's ("Intrepid") Emergency Application to Prevent Publication of Transcript ("Application"). On March 11, 2010 the Commission heard argument on the matter. The Commission, having heard argument and reviewed papers submitted by the parties, hereby


FINDS THAT:

1. No motion to seal the transcript of the October 21, 2009 hearing was made during that hearing.
2. No order to seal the transcript of the October 21, 2009 hearing was entered during or after that hearing.
3. Documents that were discussed during the October 21, 2009 hearing had been redacted for confidential material by Intrepid before distribution; therefore no confidential material was exposed as a result of discussing those documents at the October 21, 2009 hearing.
4. Based on the arguments of counsel at the March 11, 2010 hearing and related papers submitted by counsel, and on Fasken Oil and Ranch Ltd.'s lack of opposition to the Application, the Commission finds that the transcript of the October 21, 2009 hearing should be sealed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The transcript of the October 21, 2009 hearing be sealed, effective as of March 11, 2010.
