We propose to plug and abandon the above well as follows:

1. Set cement plugs at following intervals.

T.D. 1903 - 1600 ft.	Engrada	75 sacks 2 1/2 gal.
1100 - 950	Morrison	35 sacks 2 1/2 gal.
675 - 375	Dakota to Surface Csg.	100 sacks 2 1/2 gal.

2. Intervals between plugs to be filled with 9.4#/gallon drilling mud. Verbal approval to plug well obtained from Mr. E. G. Arnold March 21, 1964. Surface marker will not be erected at this time due to possibility of land-owner using well as water well.
