PSR 07-09-32: Drlg. below 4700.

PSR 07-16-32: Drlg. below 4715 in grey sand. This test will soon be below the horizon of the McAdoo well, when they will be exploring in a new zone.

PSR 07-23-32: S.D. @ 4717 in grey sand. Waiting for orders.

PSR 08-20-32: Still S.D. @ 4717. This test was said to have been fully financed to 6000', & there is some mystery as to the cause of the prolonged S.D.

PSR 10-29-32: Still S.D. @ 4717. Indications are these people are awaiting result of the McAdoo test.

PSR 12-10-32: S.D. @ 4717. We observe these people have allowed considerable state acreage near this loc. to lapse for non-payment of rentals, from which we assume it is the purpose to abandon this test.

PSR 12-24-32: S.D. @ 4717. This test is not been abandoned, we are advised by Mr. Allen Hover, an officer of the company. Will be carried down to @ least 5500', unless production is sooner encountered. However, work will not be resumed until spring.

PSR 03-04-33: T.D. 4717. Preparing to resume drlg.

PSR 09-02-33: S.D. for many months at 4717. Mr. Alan Hover, in charge of this operation, advises that he expects to resume work before cold weather, & to carry the test to at least 6000', if necessary.
