DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Filled open hole from Total depth to 1100 ft. mud and put five sacks cement. Pulled 1063 ft 85/8 casing. Then filled the hole to 675 with mud and put in 8 sacks of cement. Failed to pull all the 10" casing left 358 ft. in the hole it was left from 258 to 615. We then filled the hole from 675 to the top with mud. thus seperating any fresh water from any section of salt or salt water. Put four sacks cement in the top of the hole and also a four in. pipe four feet long.
