Mr. Griswold,

Plains Pipeline, L.P., respectfully requests NMOCD approval to conduct the following activities at the CS Caylor Release Site NMOCD Ref# AP-052. Plains proposes to install seven (7) additional monitor wells (PMW-5A, PMW-15A, PMW-16A, PMW-17A, PMW-19, PMW-20, and PMW-21) at the site. Monitor wells PMW-5A, PMW-15A, PMW-16A, and PMW-17A will be replacement wells for the existing wells MW-5, MW-15, MW-16, and MW-17. Existing wells MW-5, MW-15, MW-16, and MW-17 no longer exhibit sufficient water levels to conduct groundwater

remediation activities. The replacement wells will be installed in close proximity to the original wells. Monitor well PMW-19 will be installed to the southeast of MW-3A, PMW-20 will be installed to the northeast of MW-8A, and PMW-21 will be installed to the northeast of MW-11A. Please reference the attached Proposed Monitor Well Location Map.

Following drilling activities, MW-5, MW-15, MW-16, and MW-17 will be plugged and abandoned in accordance with applicable NMOSE guidelines. Upon NMOCD approval, Plains will commence with the described activities.


