

On November 21, 2015 and preceding dates your office was sent documentation related to a hazard/toxic liquid waste material discharge/spill that occurred in the NW4NW4 Section 5, Township 14 South, Range 36 East being in Lea County, New Mexico. As was explained within all the documents submitted our family owns lands and water wells immediately adjacent to the spill area and our requests have been for information from your office as to how the cleanup of the spill area is being monitored including monitoring of observation well completed in the immediate area to monitor potential contamination to the groundwater supply in the area. As of this date we have receive no reply or information per our requests, thus may we assume;

A- Your office has no interest in the matter and has no concern for the contamination of groundwater or soils around the spill site in Lea County New Mexico.

If you care to reply to our request or make comments regarding your offices involvement in this matter we would appreciate receipt of a letter with attachments relating to any issues regarding water and soil contamination from discharge of toxic/hazard liquids.
