Dear Ms. Garza:

The Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has completed reviewed R360 Artesia, LLC's (R360) permit minor modification request, dated May 3, 2017 and the supplemental Form C-137A dated May 9, 2017, to reduce the quarterly vadose zone monitoring frequency, required by Permit NM1-030, for total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) and volatile aromatic organics (BTEX) to semi-annual, as required of 19.15.36.E(2) NMAC. R360 also requests to utilize EPA Method 8015 modified (C₆ - C₃₆) in lieu of EPA Method 418.1 to conduct all future vadose zone and treatment zone monitoring.

OCD hereby grants R360 approval of the minor modification requests, with the following conditions:

1. R360 Artesia, LLC shall comply with all applicable requirements of the Oil and Gas Act (Chapter 70, Article 2 NMSA 1978), the existing permit NM1-30, the transitional provisions of 19.15.36.20 NMAC, and all conditions specified in this approval;
2. R360 shall monitor the vadose zone (native soils) for total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH), volatile aromatic organics (BTEX), and Chloride semi-annually; and major cations/anions and Water Quality Control Commission (WQCC) metals annually;
3. R360 shall continue to monitor the treatment zone (soils being remediated) semi-annually for TPH and Chloride to demonstrate compliance with the transitional provision of 19.15.36.20.A NMAC; and
4. Laboratory analysis shall be determined by using EPA Method 8015 modified for TPH (C₆ - C₃₆), EPA Method 8021B for BTEX, and EPA Method 6010B for WQCC metals (Subsections A, B, and C of 20.6.2.3103 NMAC – Arsenic, Barium, Cadmium,


Chromium, Lead, Total Mercury, Selenium, Silver, Copper, Iron, Manganese, Zinc, Aluminum, and Nickel) and major cations (Calcium, Magnesium, Sodium, and Potassium). Major anions (Chloride, Sulfate, and Bicarbonate) shall be analyzed by EPA Methods 300, 375, and 310, respectively.

Please be advised that approval of this request does not relieve R360 of liability should operations result in pollution of surface water, ground water or the environment. Nor does approval relieve R360 of its responsibility to comply with any other applicable governmental authority's rules and regulations.

OCD reminds R360 that the second five-year vadose zone monitoring event of 19.15.36.15.E(3) NMAC is due in 2017. Also, OCD noticed the request stated "R360 has no intentions to accept any new waste into the landfarm as we progress on a forward path towards closure of this facility." Pursuant to 19.15.36.18.A(5) NMAC, "Closure shall proceed in accordance with the approved closure and post closure plan and schedule and modifications or additional requirements the division imposes." Please review the closure conditions of the existing permit, NM1-030, and 19.15.36.18 NMAC to determine the submittal and notification requirements to obtain OCD approval prior to implementing any closure activities. The closure and post closure plan should include a responsible third party contractor's cost estimate, sufficient to close the surface waste management facility in a manner that will protect fresh water, public health and the environment, and to comply with the closure and post closure requirements contained in 19.15.36.18 NMAC and the closure conditions of the existing permit, NM1-030. This will affect your required financial assurance.

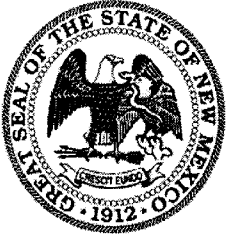

R360 Environmental Solutions (R360), submits this request for a minor modification to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) for the R360 Artesia, LLC Landfarm (NM1-030).

R360 acquired the landfarm from Artesia Aeration in April 2011 and has not accepted new material since that time. R360 has no intentions to accept any new waste into the landfarm as we progress on a forward path towards closure of this facility. Since acquisition of the landfarm, R360 has been monitoring the treatment zone semi-annually and the vadose zone quarterly. Beginning in 2017, R360 herein respectfully requests to conduct monitoring of both zones as follows:

1. In accordance with 19.15.36.15E(2), R360 shall continue to monitor the vadose zone for total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) and volatile aromatic organics (BTEX), and chloride semi-annually; and for major cations/anions and Water Quality Control Commission (WQCC) metals annually as required of the existing permit NM1-030.
2. R360 shall continue to monitor the treatment zone semi-annually for TPH and chloride to demonstrate compliance with the transitional provision of NMAC 19.15.36.20A.
3. Laboratory analysis will be determined using EPA methods 8015M for TPH (C1-C35), 8021B for BTEX, and 6010B for metals and cations. Anions (chloride, sulfate, and bicarbonate) will be analyzed by EPA methods 300, 375, and 310, respectively.


