The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has reviewed Texas-New Mexico Pipe Line Company's (TNMPLC) October 20, 1998 "CLOSURE REPORT, TNM-97-05, UNIT J, SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, JOB NO. 710035-1" which was submitted on behalf of TNMPLC by their consultant KEI. This document contains the results of TNMPLC's remediation of contaminated soils resulting from a crude oil pipeline spill from TNMPLC's TNM-97-5 spill site.
