

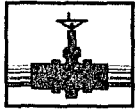

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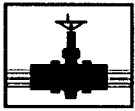

On Thursday, January 26, 2006, a meeting was held in the law offices of Heidel, Samberson, Cox, Newell and McMahon. Patrick McMahon represented the City of Lovington in the meeting. Plains personnel present were Camille Reynolds, Jeff Dann, and Mike Kelly. I was present representing OCD and Eddie Seay was present, presumably as a technical adviser to Mr. McMahon.

The city's position at this time is that not enough information has been provided to them by Plains to make an educated assessment of the conditions at the site. It was suggested, and accepted by Plains, that Plains would prepare a "delineation proposal" to the city which would describe specific actions that would be taken by Plains to properly delineate the contamination at the site. This report should be ready for presentation to the city in approximately 2 weeks (on or about February 10, 2006). After that presentation, the city would make a decision as to what type of remediation plan would be acceptable.

Plains has proposed a partial removal of source contamination (hydrocarbons) and then the installation of a liner at depth to prevent further migration. Then Plains would backfill to the surface.

The city appears to be adamant about complete source removal. Because of the depth of the contamination, this would require a huge excavation, both horizontally and vertically. Additionally, this would require the removal, or re-location of several pipelines in the vicinity. The attorneys for the city have invoked their right to determine what course of action is acceptable since they are the surface owners. Their contention is that Plains only has the rights specified in their easement granted for the pipeline. This does not include surface claims.

Currently, this is a no-win (or "slow-win") situation for all involved. If OCD approves what I believe to be a reasonable solution, the city will not let Plains onto the site to do the work. If OCD approves a complete source removal scenario, Plains will protest and bring the question before the commission. Either course of action will only delay the cleanup which may further endanger or contaminate the groundwater.

I advised Plains to try and meet with the city to work out their differences. I would like to attend such a meeting, strictly as an observer and not on anybody's side, to put forth the argument that time is of the essence and if the dispute could be resolved, everyone would benefit.

Dear Mr. Martin

As per our telephone conversation, I am writing this letter to confirm the City of Lovington's position on the remediation of the above referenced site. Of the three options offered by Plains, the City would like Plains to dig and haul *all* of their contaminants from the site. The City has based its choice on the following:

1. Plains does not have the right to leave contaminants in place. The only rights enjoyed by Plains are those specifically identified in the easement granted for the pipeline at issue. Plains has no claim to reasonable use of the surface estate. The easement covering the pipeline at issue does not give Plains the right to leave contaminants in the right of way or on City property.
2. Under the risk assessment submitted by Plains, the City, not Plains, bears the risk of leaving the contaminants in place. Namely, contamination of the aquifer used by the City to supply potable drinking water to the town of Lovington.
3. Lastly, it is the City's position that the site at issue has not been properly delineated and therefore any decision on remediation would be premature.



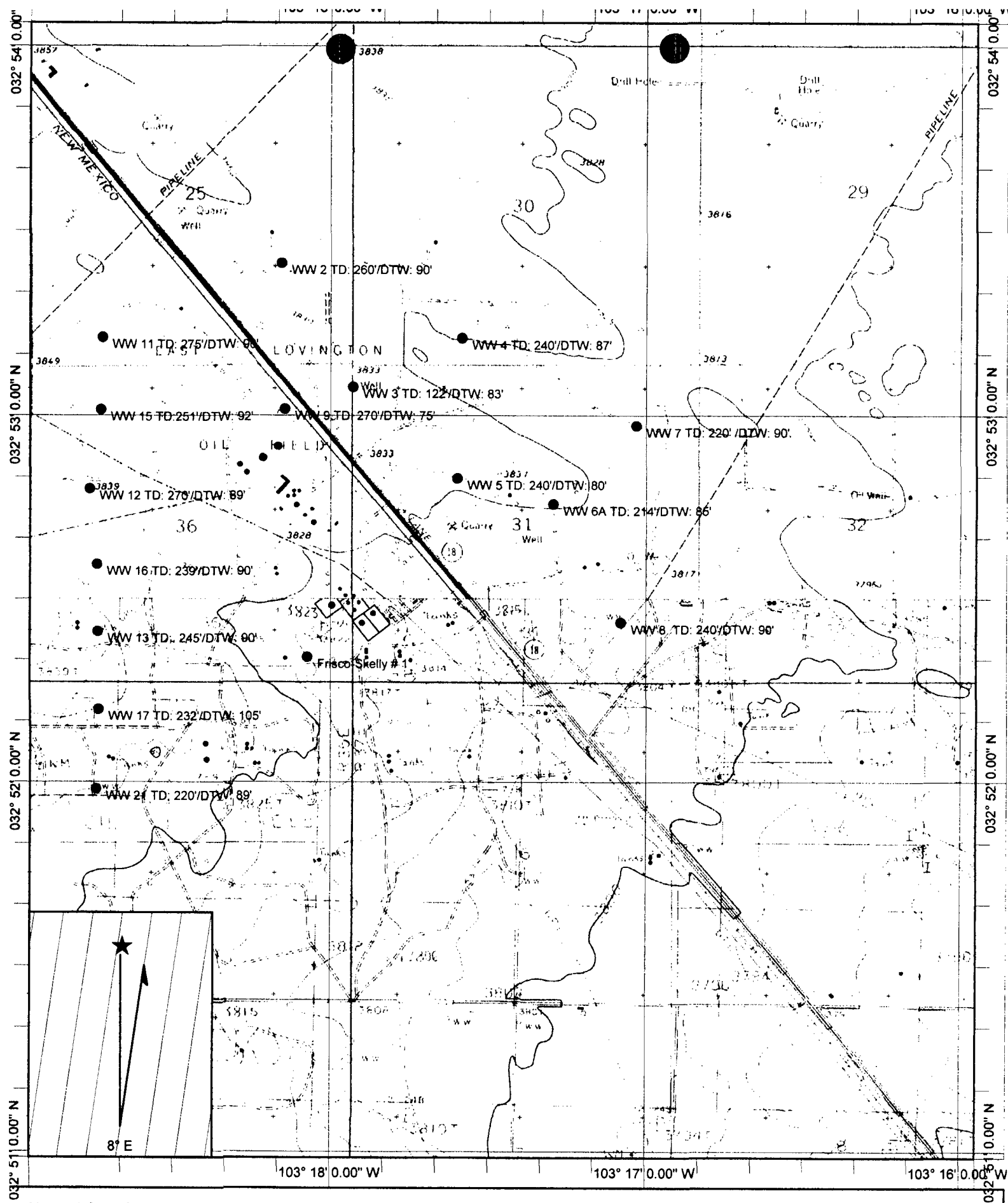

The line is a 4 inch steel transmission pipeline that produces approximately 20 to 30 barrels of crude oil per day. The pressure on the line is 28 psi and the gravity of the sweet crude oil is 39. The sweet crude has an H₂S content of <10 ppm

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* The impacted soil was excavated and stockpiled on plastic. Aerial extent of surface impact was 1,848 ft².
