Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* A producer accidentally dumped oil and water into our gathering line. This caused our line pressure to rise causing a corroded section of 12" steel gas gathering line blow out spilling accumulated crude oil and produced water on the land adjacent to the line. A pipe clamp was affixed to the pipe and vacuum trucks recovered standing oil and water. Oil soaked soil is being removed from the affected area. Land farming of the oil soaked soil will take place at CRI's approved soil remediation facility. All of the 12" steel portion of our gathering system will be replaced with new 16" poly (about 13000 Ft.) Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* A spray of oil and water affected an area about 80 yards in diameter around the leak extending mostly to the north. A stream of oil and water flowed from the leak area towards the southwest for about 300 yards forming pools. The soil is sandy loam and the area is native grassland and mesquite. Crews are currently removing the affected soil for soil remediation. I hereby certify that the information given above is true and complete to the best of my knowledge and understand that pursuant to NMOCD rules and regulations all operators are required to report and/or file certain release notifications and perform corrective actions for releases which may endanger public health or the environment. The acceptance of a C-141 report by the NMOCD marked as "Final Report" does not relieve the operator of liability should their operations have failed to adequately investigate and remediate contamination that pose a threat to ground water, surface water, human health or the environment. In addition, NMOCD acceptance of a C-141 report does not relieve the operator of responsibility for compliance with any other federal, state, or local laws and/or regulations.
