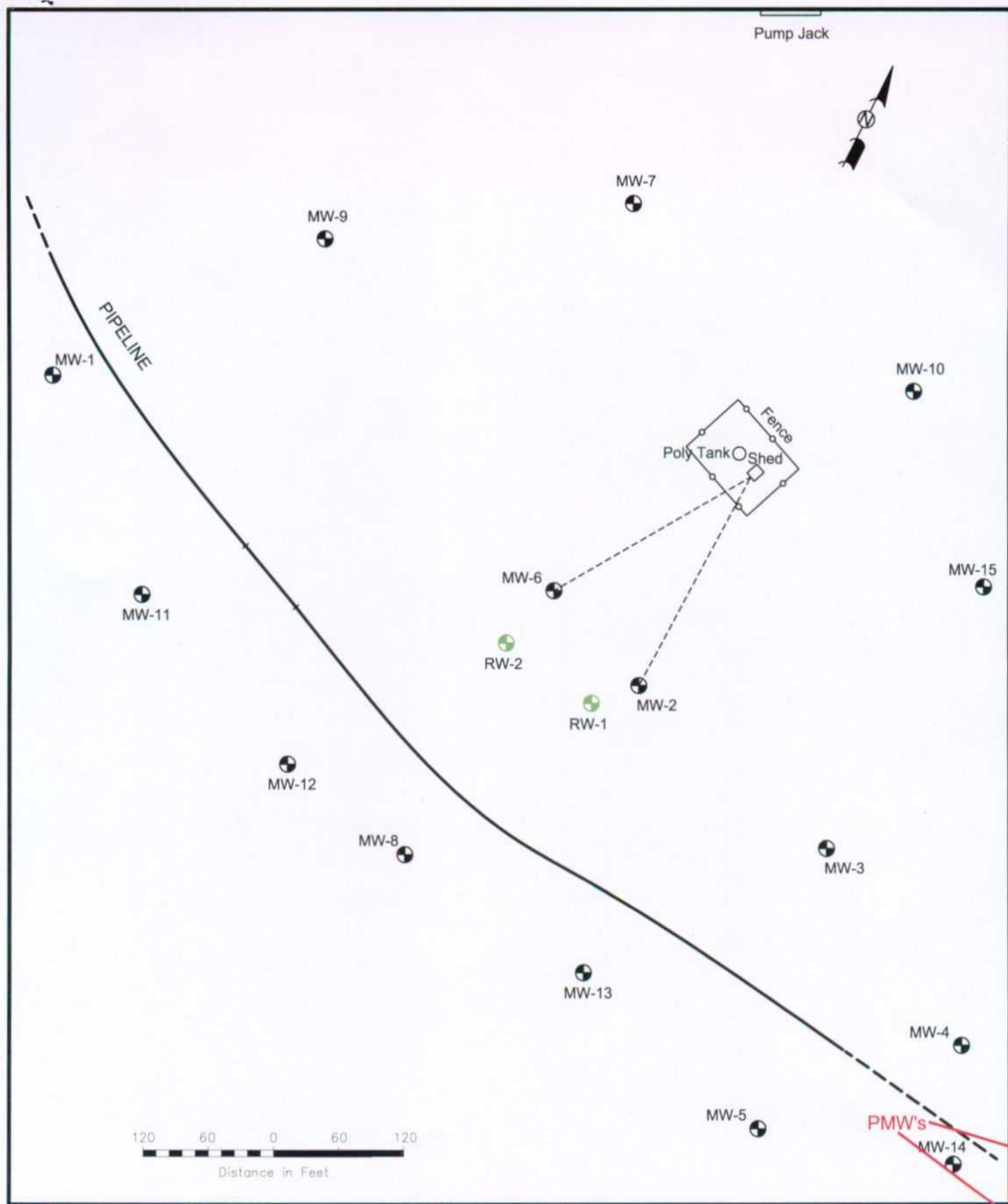

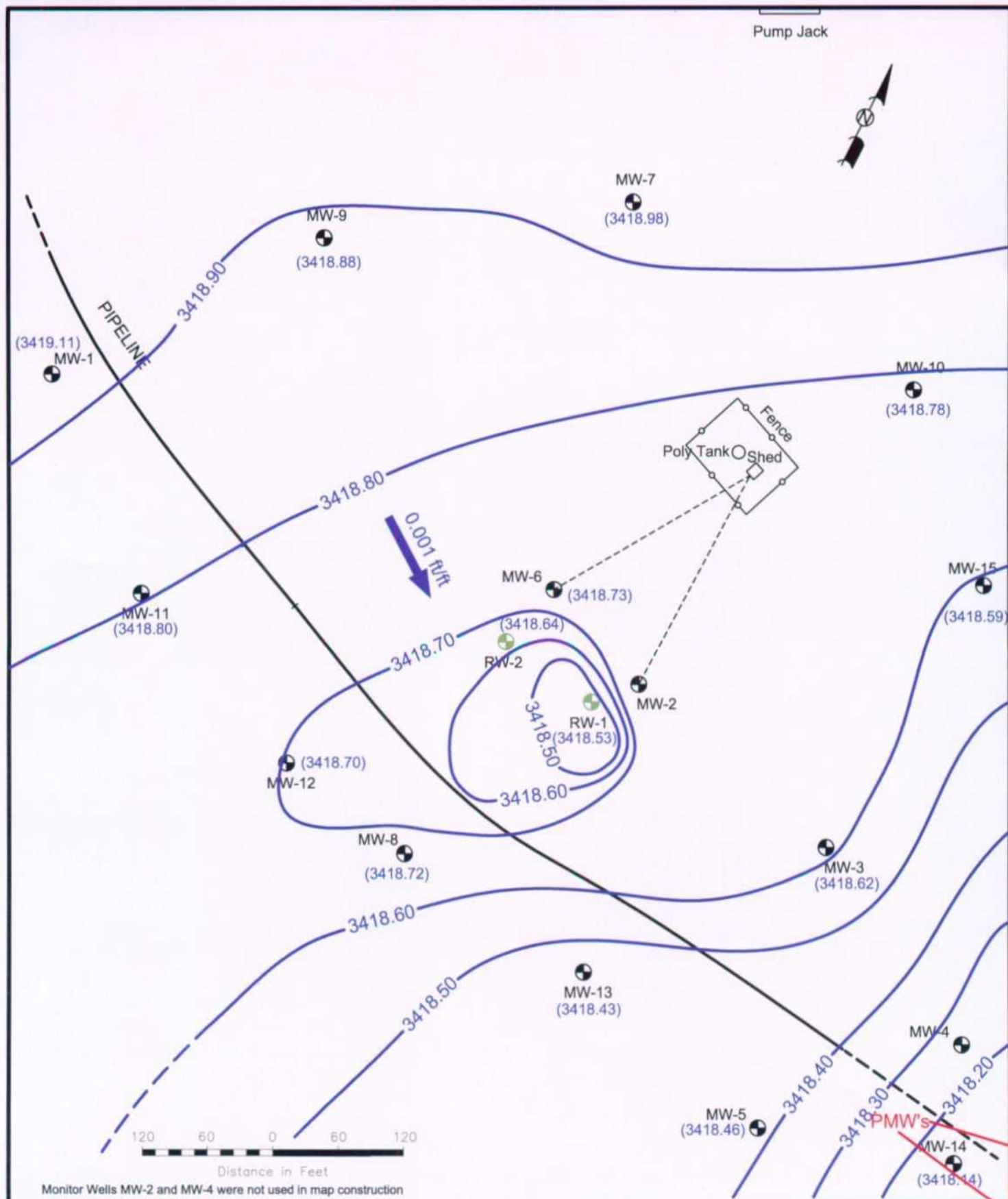

Attached please find EOTT's Subsurface Investigation Report and the Stage 2 Abatement Plan for the above captioned site. We agree with our contractor, Environmental Technology Group, Inc. (ETGI), that treating the contaminated soil using their DRIS method and using a submersible skimmer pump to recover any free phase hydrocarbon on groundwater is the most feasible way to clean up the site.

EOTT believes that after the source is cleaned up and free product is removed, the groundwater will naturally attenuate. Upon completion of the project, the monitor wells at the site will be sampled quarterly until the time four consecutive quarters of clean sampling have been achieved.

Transmitted with this letter is the Stage 1 Abatement Plan referred to in the KEI letter to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) dated June 11, 1998. I have also attached a draft Notice of Publication. Within 15 days after the OCD determines that the Stage 1 Abatement Plan is complete, TNMPL plans to issue public notice in a form approved by the OCD in a newspaper of general circulation in the county in which the release occurred, and in a newspaper of general circulation in the State. Prior to public notice, TNMPL shall give written notice, as approved by the OCD, of this Stage 1 abatement plan to the following persons:

- surface owners of record within 1 mile of the perimeter of the geographic area where the standards and requirements are exceeded
- the county commission where the geographic area where the standards and requirements are exceeded is located
- the appropriate city official(s) if the geographic area where the standards and requirements are exceeded is located
- those persons, as identified by the Director, who have requested notification, who shall be notified by mail
- the New Mexico Trustee for Natural Resources, and any other local, state, or federal governmental agency affected, as identified by the Director, which shall be notified by certified mail
- the appropriate Governor or President of any Indian Tribe, Pueblo or Nation if the geographic area where the standards and requirements set forth are exceed is located or is partially located within tribal boundaries or within 1 mile of the tribal boundaries, who shall be notified by certified mail.
