The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) has received and reviewed the letter, dated May 31, 2006, concerning the above site and its associated abatement plan, submitted on behalf of Plains Marketing, L.P. (Plains) by BBC International, Inc. This letter was in response to the NMOCD letter dated May 17, 2005 approving Abatement Plan AP-36 and sought to clarify certain points. Listed below are the points requiring clarification and the NMOCD response:

- 1. Abatement Plan AP-36 modified for this point. Testing and analysis for TDS and major cations/anions, in groundwater, will not be required. Mr. Cliff Brunson and the undersigned in a telephone conversation agreed upon this change in principle.
- 2. No Change. OK.
- 3. Abatement Plan AP-36 modified for this point. Since installation of additional monitor or recovery wells is not warranted, requirements 3.b and 3.f of the May 17, 2005 letter are unnecessary.
- 4. No Change. OK.

The NMOCD further agrees to amend Abatement Plan AP-36 as shown on page 2 of the letter dated May 31, 2006. Actions described in the second paragraph following #4 on page 2 are hereby incorporated into the abatement plan.

Pursuant to our discussion on May 31, 2006, BBC International, Inc., (BBC) on behalf of Plains Marketing, L. P. (Plains), respectfully submits the following closure plan to finalize the soil and groundwater remediation phase of the above referenced site.

In the letter from the NMOCD to Plains Marketing dated May 17, 2005 approving the Stage 1 and Stage 2 Abatement Plan (AP-36), there were four (4) conditions listed for the approval. As we discussed in your office in June 2005, there are some clarifications and changes required. I will address them in the order listed in the letter. The NMOCD letter of May 17, 2005 is attached for your reference.

- 1. **Change Required:** Based on our conversation, the NMOCD indicated testing for TDS and anions/cations would not be required. Groundwater has been and will continue to be sampled and analyzed on a quarterly basis for concentrations of BTEX using EPA-approved methods and quality assurance/quality control (QA/QC) procedures until 8 consecutive non-detect quarters are achieved.
- 2. **No Change:** All wastes generated will be disposed of at an NMOCD-approved facility. The wastes are comprised of excavated soils and purged groundwater.
- 3. **Change Required:** Plains has and will continue submitting an annual report containing the results of any and all remediation activities and monitoring activities by April 1st of each year. Plains agrees with the following components of this condition: a, c, d, e. Conditions "b" and "f" require revisions. Condition "b" requires logs for the construction of any soil borings, monitor wells, or recovery wells. As we discussed,

one of the remedial options mentioned in the Stage 2 Plan was the installation of recovery wells, however, based on the current groundwater data, installation of additional monitor or recovery wells does not appear warranted. The proposed plan will be discussed further in the following text. Condition "f" also refers to the monthly volume of water pumped from the recovery wells and the total volume pumped. As previously stated, there will be no recovery wells so this condition is not applicable.

4. **No Change:** Plains will notify the NMOCD at least 48 hours in advance of all scheduled activities so the NMOCD has the opportunity to witness the events and split samples.

Plains hereby requests the NMOCD approval to amend the previously approved Abatement Plan with the following:

The TNM 97-23 site has approximately 3, 277 cubic yards of soil excavated and stockpiled at the site ready for disposal. Plains proposes to transport this impacted soil to their NMOCD-approved land farm near Oil Center, NM. There would be no further excavation of soil. The excavated site, which is approximately 600 feet long by 20 feet wide by 6 feet deep running east to west and approximately 185 feet long by 15 feet wide by 4 feet deep running north to south, would be lined at the bottom of the excavation with a synthetic liner then backfilled to surface with sand (similar type of native soil that was excavated). Upon completion of the backfilling, only the quarterly groundwater monitoring activities would continue until closure. Plains will provide a soil closure report to the NMOCD upon completion of soil remediation activities. The modification of the previously planned site treatment cells would satisfy the land owner's instructions of no treatment cells on her land.

I believe this covers all that we discussed. Plains appreciates your cooperation in the closure of the soil portion of this site and looks forward to your expeditious approval of this modification. Remediation activities will commence as soon as possible upon the NMOCD's approval of these modifications.





The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division has received and reviewed the report shown above. The report is hereby approved. Thank you.

In reviewing our files, we find that Abatement Plan AP-036 was deemed administratively complete on January 23, 2004. In the NMOCD letter of that date, it was requested that, among other things, Plains provide the NMOCD with proof of public notice in the newspaper and proof of notice to landowners within one mile of the site. 

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
