In accordance with Rule 19 (Section 19.15.1.19 NMAC, Subsection G) Public Notice requirements, please accept the enclosed copies of proof that the appropriate individuals and entities were notified of the Stage 1 Abatement Plan submitted by the consulting firm of Arcadis G & M of Midland, Texas for the EME jct. A-20 site.

Notices were sent via certified mail to landowners within the prescribed radius and return receipts were received for all landowners, indicating that the mailing was received. Mailings were also sent to the Lea County Commission and the list of Interested Parties found on the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) website. Some mail deliveries could not be confirmed so the document was sent via electronic mail (e-mail) to the addresses provided on the list. Thirty-three total notifications were sent and two were not delivered, both from the OCD Interested Parties list. The notification to Mike Schultz of the International Technology Corp. was refused delivery and Gerald R. Zimmerman of the Colorado River Board of California could not be notified by US Mail nor e-mail.

As directed by OCD, the Stage 1 Abatement Plan notifications were published in the *Albuquerque Journal* and the *Hobbs News-Sun* newspapers. Affidavits for these publications are enclosed.

ROC requests that OCD consider public notice complete for this site. Should you have any further questions regarding this request, do not hesitate to contact me. Thank you for your consideration.

ROC is the service provider (operator) for the EME SWD System and has no ownership of any portion of the pipeline, well, or facility. The System is owned by a consortium of oil producers, System Partners, who provide all operating capital on a percentage ownership/usage basis.

On behalf of Rice Operating Company (ROC), ARCADIS G&M, Inc. (ARCADIS) respectfully submits the 2005 Monitor Well Report for the EME Jct. A-20 site located in the Eunice Monument Eumont (EME) Salt Water Disposal (SWD) System.

One monitoring well was installed in 2002 during delineation as part of the Junction Box Upgrade Program. This well is sampled quarterly pursuant to New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) guidelines. ARCADIS has been contracted by ROC to address groundwater concerns at the site. Environmental Lab of Texas of Odessa continued to conduct analytical tests of the water samples in 2005.

Soon after the well was installed, phase-separated hydrocarbon (PSH) was found on the water. ROC has actively worked at recovering the PSH in the well by hand bailing or by using an absorbent sock. In September of 2004 Basin Environmental Service Technologies (Basin) assumed the maintenance and weekly replacement of the socks; PSH thickness and volume are measured weekly. Basin will continue weekly recovery in 2006 unless an alternate remedial method is proposed and approved by NMOCD.

The attached table summarizes the analytical results from groundwater samples collected from the monitor well at the site. Overall, chloride and total dissolved solids (TDS) concentrations have remained relatively consistent since sampling was initiated. TDS concentrations increased in 2005 from a concentration of 4,290 mg/L

to 5,310 mg/L. Chloride concentrations remained fairly consistent in 2005 ranging from a concentration of 2,330 mg/L to 2,460 mg/L. Samples were not analyzed for hydrocarbon compounds as PSH is present in the well.

A Stage 1 Abatement Plan was submitted to NMOCD on June 23, 2005 and approved as administratively complete on November 18, 2005. Public Notice was submitted to the NMOCD on November 28, 2005 and published in the Albuquerque Journal and Hobbs News Sun on December 10, 2005.

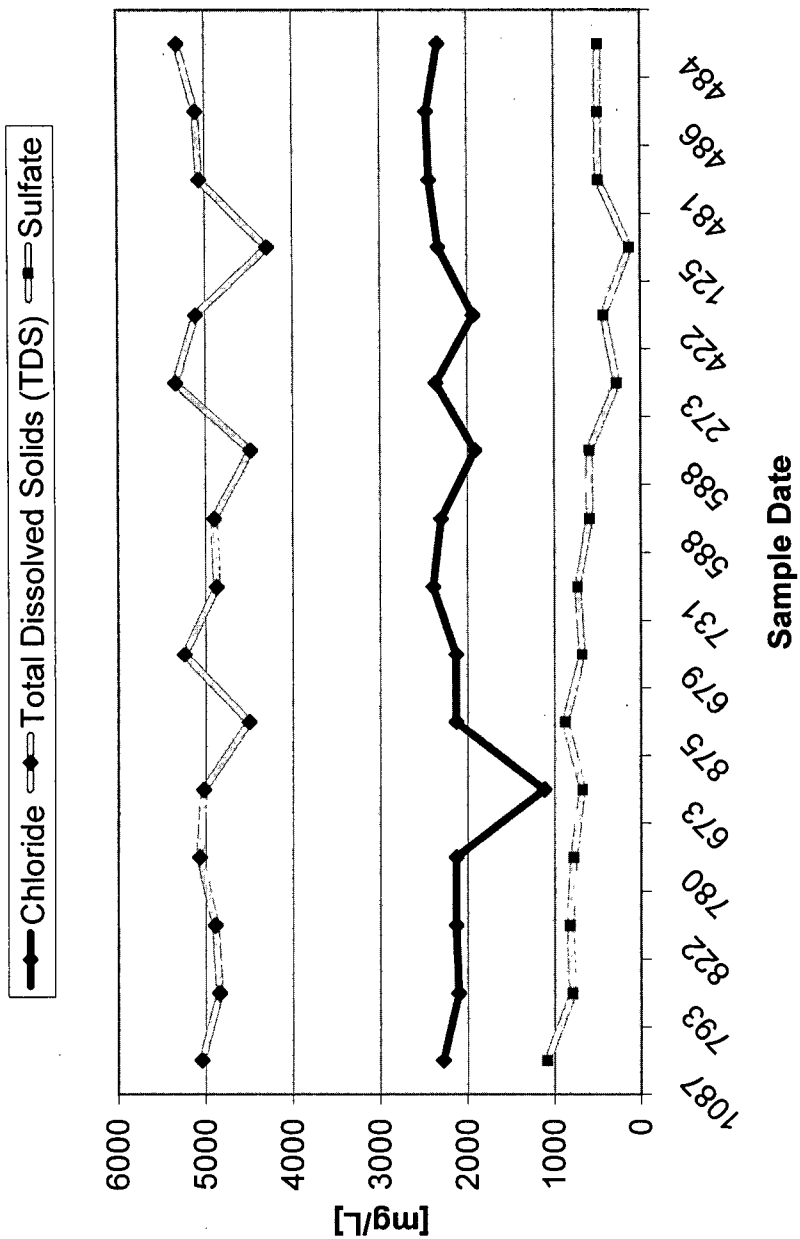

One monitoring well was installed on 1/9/2002 during delineation as part of the Junction Box Upgrade Program. This well is sampled quarterly pursuant to NMOCD guidelines. ARCADIS has been contracted by ROC to address groundwater concerns at the site. Environmental Lab of Texas of Odessa continued to conduct analytical tests of the water samples in 2005.

The attached table summarizes the analytical results from groundwater samples collected from the monitor well at the site. Overall, chloride and total dissolved solids (TDS) concentrations have remained relatively consistent since sampling was initiated. TDS concentrations decreased in 2005 from a concentration of 7,810 mg/L to 6,600 mg/L. Likewise, chloride concentrations decreased in 2005 from a concentration of 2,470 mg/L to 1,700 mg/L. No hydrocarbons were detected in any of the samples analyzed in 2005.

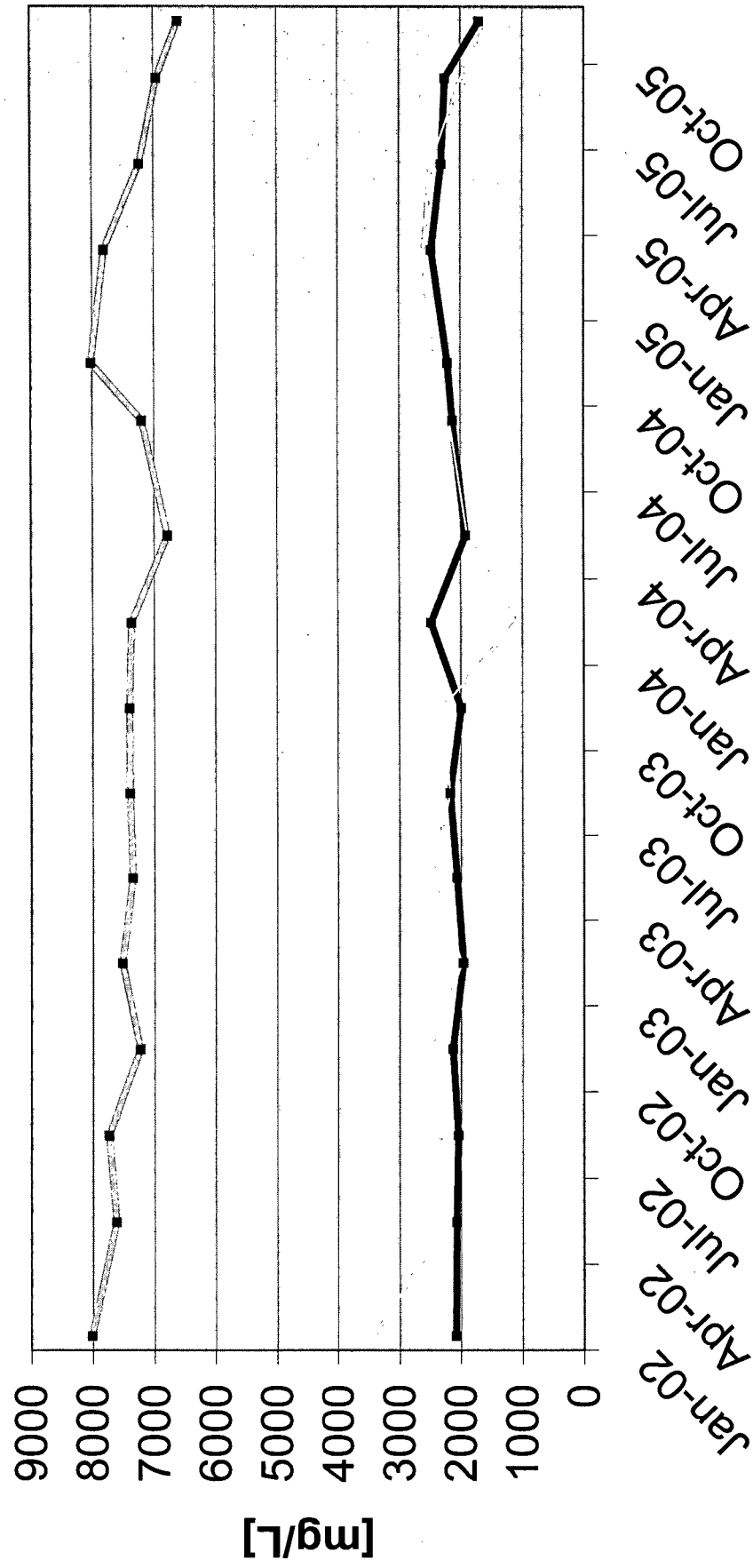


