Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 520-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Twp. 22 South, Rgs. 36 East, NMPM
NE/4, SE/4 NW/4, S/2 of Section 16

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to and the production therefrom divided between your State-McDonald A/c-1 Well No. 25, located 1980' from the North line and 660' from the East line of Section 16; and your State-McDonald A/c-1 Well No. 6, located 1980' from the West line and 660' from the South line of Section 16.

It is further stipulated that neither of the gas wells on this proration unit shall be permitted to produce a volume of gas during any proration period to exceed 75% of the allowable which would actually be assigned to the above mentioned proration unit for such proration period.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 520 acres.
