Amended Administrative Order NSP-106(L)

Dear Mr. Westbrook:

Reference is made to your application of September 12, 1989 to reinstate the previously approved 80-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool (Administrative Order NSP-106 dated March 16, 1955) comprising the N/2 NE/4 of Section 11, Township 2 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that the original well dedicated to this unit, the Amoco McQuatters Well No. 1 located 660 feet from the North and East lines of said Section 11, was plugged back to the Eunice Monument Pool and was turned over to the Chevron U.S.A., Inc. Eunice Monument South Unit in January, 1987.

Furthermore, it is our understanding that this unit will now be dedicated to a replacement well, the McQuatters Well No. 1, to be drilled at an unorthodox gas well location 860 feet from the North line and 2100 feet from the East line (Unit B) of said Section 14.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rules 2(c) and 2(a)4 of the Special Rules for the Eumont Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location and non-standard gas proration unit are hereby approved.
