In its letter of June 29, 1955, the Gulf Oil Corporation made application to the Oil Conservation Commission for approval of a nonstandard gas proration unit comprising the E/2 of Section 25, T-20-S, R-36-E, Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. The proposed gas proration unit is to be assigned to Gulf's L. W. White No. 2 for gas allocation purposes.

We should like to advise that the Stanolind Oil and Gas Company had tentatively agreed to dedicate to this unit its Gillully "A" Lease, comprising 80 acres in the W/2 of the NE/4 of Section 25. Contingent upon approval of this application, Gulf and Stanolind have agreed to enter into a gas pooling agreement and an operating agreement covering the above described gas proration unit.

As indicated by Gulf's application, the proposed unit consists of continuous and contiguous acreage lying wholly within a single governmental section, and all of the acreage may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas. There is no other well within the limits of the proposed unit to which the acreage may currently be assigned for gas proration purposes, and approval of this proposed unit will avoid the completion of an additional and unnecessary well. As a working interest participant, we believe the proposed unit will prevent waste and protect correlative rights and we respectfully request its approval by the Commission.

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as its L. W. White Lease located in the SE/4 and E/2 of the NE/4 of Section 25, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Stanolind Oil and Gas Company is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease located in the W/2 of the NE/4 of Section 25, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The Gulf and Stanolind leases comprise the 320 acres above described.
- (2) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of the L. W. White #2 located 660 feet from the east line and 1980 feet from the south line of Section 25, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, which was dually completed June 20, 1955, between 3352 and 3572 feet in the Eumont Gas Pool and the Eunice Oil Pool.
- (3) Contingent upon obtaining Conservation Commission approval of this application for the non-standard 320-acre gas proration unit, Gulf Oil Corporation and Stanolind Oil and Gas Company have agreed to enter into/ a gas pooling agreement and an operating agreement covering the above described 320 acres for the purpose of producing their respective shares of Eumont Pool gas under such acreage and have agreed to use the Gulf Oil Corporation L. W. White #2 as the Unit well.

- (4) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
 - (d) The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
 - (e) By copy of this letter of application, all operators owning interest in the section in which the proposed unit is located and all operators within 1500 feet of the proposed unit well are notified by registered mail of the intent of Gulf Oil Corporation and Stanolind Oil and Gas Company to form the proposed non-standard gas proration unit. 
