Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas provation unit comprising the $\mathbb{W}/2$ of the $\mathbb{E}/2$ and $\mathbb{E}/2$ of the $\mathbb{W}/2$ Section 14, T-21-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is the operator of oil and gas leases known as (a) the Henry C. Collins Lease described as the E/2 of the W/2, W/2 of the SE/4, and SW/4 of the NE/4 Section 14, T-21-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico; and (b) the F. Leck Lease described as the NH/4 of the NE/4 of the same section. These two leases are to be pooled to form the 320-acre gas provation unit above described.
- (2) The Henry C. Collins #4 located 1980 feet from the west and south lines of Section 14, T-21-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Maxico, was originally completed on March 14, 1937 at a depth of 3880 feet in the Eunice Oil Pool. This well was recompleted on July 14, 1955, as a Eumont Pool gas well at a plug back depth of 3653 feet after perforating the casing opposite the Queen Formation at various intervals between 3473 feet and 3640 feet. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:

- (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
- (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
- (d) The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
- (e) By copy of this letter of application, all operators owning interest in the section in which the proposed unit is located and all operators within 1500 feet of the proposed unit well are notified by registered mail of the intent of Gulf Oil Corporation to form the proposed non-standard gas proration unit. (See attached affidavit.)

In view of the existence of the facts herein stated and compliance with the provisions of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. R-520, Gulf Oil Corporation requests that the Secretary of the Commission approve the above described non-standard gas proration unit.

Dear Sir:

Gulf Oil Corporation is the Operator for a 320 acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the E/2 W/2 and W/2 E/2 of Section 14, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico. The unit well is Gulf Oil Corporation's H. C. Collins Well No. 4 located in the NE/4 SW/4 of said Section 14. An application for the approval of this non-standard gas proration unit was filed, and by your Administrative Order NSP-182 you approved the formation of the unit and provided for an allowable in accordance with pool rules based upon a unit of 320 acres.

Gulf Oil Corporation, Skelly Oil Company, and Texas Gulf Producing Company together own all of the leasehold interest in two oil and gas leases covering the E/2 W/2, W/2 SE/4 and SW/4 NE/4 of Section 14 under one lease and the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 14 under the other. The three companies have agreed to pool their respective interests for the production of gas from this unit within the limits of the Eumont Gas Pool and the Pooling Agreement is in the process of preparation for execution.

Pursuant to the practice heretofore followed by the Commission, you are requested to place the unit well upon the gas proration schedule, effective immediately, allocating to it an allowable based upon the 320 acre unit in the Eumont Gas Pool.

Dear Sir:

Please refer to our letter to you dated September 14, 1955, whereby we requested that Gulf Oil Corporation's H. C. Collins Well No. 4 located in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 14, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico, being the unit gas well for the captioned unit, be placed upon the gas proration schedule, effective immediately and that an allowable be allocated to it based upon the 320 acre unit in the Eumont Gas Pool.

Since Gulf Oil Corporation, Skelly Oil Company, and Texas Gulf Producing Company jointly own all of the working interest under the two fee oil and gas leases covering all of the 320 acres in the subject gas unit and said acreage is operated for oil and gas under the terms of an existing Unit Operating Contract, dated January 3, 1936, which provides that Gulf Oil Corporation will be Operator for the unit, we are of the opinion that the working interest in the subject gas unit is effectively communitized and no additional instrument of agreement is necessary. The royalty interests under the two leases are, according to our records, identical and for this reason, we believe no other instrument is needed to effectively communitize such royalty interests for the purposes of the gas unit.
