Plains Marketing, L.P. is pleased to submit the attached 2019 Annual Monitoring Report and Closure Request, dated January 2020, for the Lea Station Landfarm. This landfarm is located in the W 1/2, NW 1/4 of Section 28 Township 20 South, Range 37 East of Lea County, New Mexico. The analytical results for the last three (3) treatment zone sampling events indicate all active landfarm treatment cells exhibit total petroleum hydrocarbon (TPH) and chloride concentrations below NMOCD regulatory guidelines. Based on the analytical results, Plains will terminate the tilling of the landfarm cells and the semi-annual treatment zone sampling events. Upon NMOCD approval Plains will proceed with closure activities.
