• The entire area has not been remediated to meet closure criteria where depth to groundwater is <50' below ground surface. Table 3a indicates an exceedance in sample S7 with respect to TPH, and it appears this sample was left in-situ.

The site characterization is approved, including the background sample data. In the future, please do not amend the C-141 in a way that consists of removing text from the form.
