Oil storage tanks overflowed into the lined SPCC containment.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
Approximately 33BBLS of oil was released as a result of a hole in the bottom of the oil storage tank. A vacuum truck was dispatched and approximately 33BBLS oil was recovered. All fluids remained inside the lined SPCC containment. Once fluids were removed the liner was visually inspected by Devon field staff for any pinholes or punctures and none were found. Based on this inspection there is no evidence that the spill fluids left containment.
