As stated in my last report at the time I was changing from a cable tool rig to a rotary because of some loose formation caving, I have finally managed to get a rotary rig on location for the purpose of coring the Dakota SS which I topped at 1750'. I have ordered a reamer to run to total depth to be sure that the bore is in first class shape for the core barrel. I have had no water at all in this well but gas has been showing for the past 450' which is not unusual for this area. However, I am confident of a producing well at this location or I would have given up long ago. Am taking every precaution to have the proper weight mud to protect the hole. I regret that a rotary rig has been difficult to find due to the heavy water well drilling due to the very dry season but I have a very good rig at last.
