2. Set 35 sack cement plug 3088 to 3128 feet.
3. Weld steel cap on top of 9 5/8 inch casing.

It is planned to pull as much 9 5/8 inch casing as can be recovered. This work is expected to be done after the removal of the rig, estimated to be in 2 to 4 weeks. After pulling casing the location will be levelled, cleared and marked.
