In our recent telephone conversation we discussed the plugging of the captioned well but the gamma - Neutron log which I ran in this well justifies perforating from 942 - 952' in the Dakota formation, hence the notice of change of plans in the accompanying forms C-102.

I returned home while the rig on location moved away to drill two water wells under contract and I have been ill again since my return but I shall return to New Mexico within the next ten days if my health improves sufficiently, and if not I shall notify you of my desire for additional time.

In the event of plugging I should like to know the amount of plugging mud you would have me run per hundred feet of 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " O D pipe.

I understand that a well near Roy, New Mexico has some favorable shows but I am in no position to confirm this report that a uranium test hole had some oil which is prompting plans for drilling.

Somewhere in the Raton Basin there must be some oil and I shall do all that I possibly can to prove it.

My apologies for any infraction of your rules in the past and I shall be careful to carry out your instructions in the future.

I am preparing a request for Mrs. Francis Rinehart to sign that she be permitted to use the Rinehart No. 1 as a water well on her ranch as it has excellent fresh water and she is unable to finance the drilling of a well on her ranch as wells of value must go to the Dakota sand which cost approximately \$4,400.00 to drill.

In my phone conversation with you recently I stated that I wished to plug the above described well but after running a Gamma - Neutron log it was decided that the well should be perforated from 942 to 952' in view of the gas show that was encountered in this zone during drilling, hence this request for permission to perforate which will be done shortly after your approval and a rig can be moved back to location.

I have been ill again since I talked with you but will be able to return to work within the next ten days.

After perforating and testing I shall be ready to plug the well as per your instructions, and abandon same but I feel that every effort should be made to develop the well into a producer if possible.
