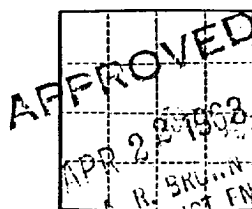

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Total depth of well is 3037 feet. 10-3/4" casing set and cemented at 238 feet. 5" casing set and cemented at 2710 feet with 275 sacks. Attempted to run tubing to total depth but tubing would not go below a depth of 340 feet. Apparently, well is plugged at this depth. Mudded hole and set a 50-sack plug at 170 to 340 feet, and a 10-sack plug from surface to a depth of 25 feet. Erected regulation marker and cleaned location. Well was plugged and abandoned on April 10, 1963.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
