Please be advised that I ~~have~~ not started work plugging wells in question on the above estate. Due to a few reverses on our work schedule, it looks like I will be able to commence work on this project shortly after Sept., 15.

In regard to your letter to Mr. J. E. Kaptiens, of which I recieved a copy, lookt and there was that Shambhushad had admired the well at the time he could use it for a water well.

I advised him that in the past that the Commission had allowed this and that he would have to complete their form for acceptance. I further advised him that the usual plugging procedures would have to be followed except for the surface plug and Marker. He demanded to be notified before work was started on the well in question that is on his land.

It is my understanding that I will plug this well as to the commissions requirements before turning it over to Mr. Schmitz which will require all plugs to be set, hole mudded with heavy mud between all plugs and recover all of the 4 1/2 " casing possible.

I am sorry about being delayed on getting this work done, but I am sure we will be able to start soon after September 15, at which all parties concerned will be notified..
