The last report of drilling operations on the Lee Burns "A" Well No. 1 located in Unit P of Section 31, Township 6 North, Range 8 East, NMPM, Torrance County, New Mexico, received by this office June 26, 1967, and postmarked Salina, Kansas, indicate that operations ceased prior to June 19, 1967. You are hereby informed that you are in violation of Rule 202 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rules and Regulations, and you are called upon to plug said well in a manner to be prescribed by this office. A reasonable length of time, 15 days, will be allowed for plugging operations to be started or the matter shall be referred to the Legal Department for further action.
