Dear Sir:

I have just received a bill from the James H. Auscraft Agency for removal of Bond #1358466 from August 29, 1954 to August 29, 1955.

After I abandoned the Ferrol L. Smith #1, Union County, New Mexico, I personally made a telephone call to the Oil Conservation Commission and got instructions on how to plug the Smith #1 well. These instructions were followed to the letter. The hole was filled with mud weighing 9.7 pounds and a cement plug put in the top. I am enclosing an electric log of the well. This shows that there were not any salt water sands that could possibly contaminate anything. In fact, there were not even any fresh water sands. I spent about \$400 building a fence around the site to protect the cattle, and cleaning off the location.

If there is anything else I can do to get this bond released, please let me know and I will take care of it immediately.
