Once the liner is installed, the excavation will be backfilled with clean, imported top soil and contoured to the surrounding location. The site will be seeded with a blend of native vegetation. Once these activities have been completed, a Termination Request will be submitted to NMOCD and BLM requesting 'remediation termination' and site closure.
