Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

The 3" poly line was cut by a road grader operated by MJ Services. The well was shut in and the damaged section of pipe was cut out and replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* The spill impacted approximately 3,500 sq. ft. of caliche lease road and misted approximately 400 sq. ft. of pasture. The saturated soil was scraped up and stockpiled at the Hudson Federal Battery pending removal. Clean caliche was used to re-cover the exposed line. The release area was excavated and contaminated soil hauled to a state approved disposal facility. Based on laboratory analytical data and NMOCD approval the excavation has been backfilled with clean soil. The area has been remediated in accordance to the NMOCD and BLM guidelines for spill remediation.

I hereby certify that the information given above is true and complete to the best of my knowledge and understand that pursuant to NMOCD rules and regulations all operators are required to report and/or file certain release notifications and perform corrective actions for releases which may endanger public health or the environment.
